



Create A Poem With Music

Lesson Plan

Need for activity:

Electronic device, paper or worksheet provided, and writing utensils

"Three Little Birds" by Bob Marley music
video w/ lyrics

Introduction

Introduce the lesson. This lesson is to be done with adult, friends, or alone. The point of the lesson is to create a poem with music. The song we chose for this lesson is "Three Little Birds" by Bob Marley. The teen is to listen to the song (we provided a link to youtube video of song with lyrics). Once the teen listens to song they need to use worksheet to answer questions. The questions on worksheet go along with the lesson so please use those for the lesson and to have teen use to create their poem. The creativity can be endless and is encouraged to be as creative as possible.



Activity:

Now it's time to start activity! The teen will need to be provided with the worksheet or if no printer use paper, and writing utensils. Again use video link we provided and have teen listen to song. Answer questions on worksheet (ex. Write down feelings and thoughts triggered by song). Answering the questions will give ideas and help on creating a poem based off of the song. The poem can be short or long, can rhyme or just be words. There is no right or wrong way to do this lesson! Encourage the teen to be engaged and as creative as possible, while also having fun!

Conclusion:

Once the teen is done with their poem have them share it with an adult, friends, post it on social media. Not only is this great for the teen to express themselves and use creativity, but great to share with others.

Overview and Purpose:

The teen will learn how to create a poem from their own creativity using a song. The activity teaches the teen literacy, writing, and meaning of song/lyrics.
